

OGCC Dress Code

In keeping with the traditions of a private club and the standards desired by the membership as a whole, certain guidelines for appropriate attire for the various activities at the club have been adopted. We wish to identify a selection of mandatory and optional attire that will assist you and your guests in the fully enjoying the club and its activities. When in doubt, please ask our professional staff.

Golf Course

Golf attire must be tailored and in good taste. Tailored knee to mid-thigh shorts are permitted. Golf sandals are permitted.

Hats are to be worn properly.

Socks are optional. If worn with shorts, socks must be ankle or knee-high length (colour must be in good taste).

For inclement or cold weather, nylon warm-ups or rain suits over golf attire may be worn.

Non-golf related logos may not exceed four inches in diameter.

Short and long sleeve mock turtlenecks are permitted. Cargo shorts are permitted providing they are tailored and in good taste.

Men Specific

Golf shirts must have a collar or turtleneck or mock turtleneck with sleeves and must be worn tucked into trousers.

Ladies Specific

Shirts must be tucked in/out as designed by manufacturer. Capri slacks are acceptable.

Examples of prohibited attire:

- Jeans, jean jackets, denim outfits.
- Jogging pants, rugby pants, tee shirts, tank tops and tube tops.
- Short shorts.
- Turf-damaging shoes or street shoes.

Clubhouse

Attire outlined under golf is acceptable; curling attire acceptable during curling season.

Dining Rooms

Smart Casual - Jacket and tie are not mandatory. Collared shirt and slacks are appropriate.

Children under thirteen must be properly attired. Denim skirts, dresses and shirts are permitted.

Jeans in good taste are permitted, meaning not torn, frayed, ripped, tattered or dirty and must be worn snugly above the hips.

Examples of prohibited attire:

jogging pants, rugby pants, tee shirts, tank tops, tube tops, short shorts and attire with large writing, logos and outside stitching of contrasting colour.
